*** The following CoVid Protocol Procedures will be in place unless the CDC changes guidelines prior to camp. Parents will be notified by email if there are any changes

1. Number of campers reduced by one half.
2. Masks will be worn by all instructors and adult staff
3. Masks should be worn by all campers.
4. Pictures and Any Snack Breaks will be outside weather pending
5. Drop Off and Pick up time will be staggered
6. Limit of those students 4 and under will be at 15. These 'little's will have their own class
7. Staggered Showoff time to reduce number in gyms to 50-75 percent
8. Daily Temperature checks upon arrival
9. Campers and Staff will stay in the same place, with the same people daily
10. Camp will be divided by two, late and early staggered times
